Dark Sky Festival Art Contest

Deadline to submit artwork is February 29th

Students in Fountain Hills will have the chance to win cash and showcase their art at the annual Dark Sky Festival in March.



Students K-5 can submit drawings or paintings (no digital art) illustrating our dark sky. This year's theme is DISCOVER THE NIGHT SKY. Students can begin their work anytime, at home or as a school assignment, but can only enter one art piece in each category.

High school and middle school students can submit drawings, paintings, or digital art. Entries must be sized 8.5 x 11 to 22 x 28, landscape orientation preferred. Complete guidelines and entry blanks may be obtained from art teachers at each school. Home schooled students can get more information from peggy.yeargain@gmail.com or cindycarolcouture@hotmail.com. All artwork must be submitted with a signed parent permission entry form taped to the back.

Grade level prize categories include: Kindergarten, 1-3, 4-5, 6-8, and 9-12. The top 10 pieces from each grade level category will be on display in the Community Center during the week leading up to the festival. First place winners in each category (except kindergarten) will receive \$100, second place \$50 and third place \$25. Kindergarten winners will receive \$25 each for the top three entries. Winners will be notified by email and prizes will be awarded at the Dark Sky Festival on March 30th at the opening festivities in the Community Center Ballroom.

The deadline to submit artwork to your art teacher, a school district office, or to Peggy Yeargain or Cindy Couture is **February 29th**. The submissions will be picked up the day after the deadline at each Fountain Hills School office, or you may contact Cindy or Peggy to drop them off.
